

## International Killing of Pre-born

The World Health Organization (WHO) recently published a second edition of *“Safe Abortion: technical and policy guidance for health systems.”*

## The Supreme Court Has Ruled

In a most contentious 5-4 decision, the U.S. Supreme Court has ruled the Affordable Care Act – commonly known as ObamaCare – constitutional.

This pro-abortion, pro-rationing legislation is riddled with anti-life measures. We can expect the number of abortions to sky-rocket, funded by taxpayers through a monthly surcharge.

Rationing of medical care will lead to passive and active euthanasia [killing] of our elderly and chronically ill.

In the thousands of pages of legislating text, we also can expect our daily lives to be regulated in a great variety of ways.

## Komen & Planned Parenthood

After a mafia-style onslaught of Komen by Planned Parenthood for Komen’s attempt to drop all funding for PP, **Komen has crumbled** – in spite of the fact that PP does not do mammograms.

Deja vu. Before ObamaCare was passed in the House, pro-life people were counting on Rep. Bart Stupak and his coalition to stop the legislation. However, Stupak caved and ObamaCare passed. Now ObamaCare has passed through the Supreme Court. Pro-life people were counting on Chief Justice John Roberts to reject the legislation. According to some reports, Roberts was going to do just that but, then, like Stupak, he changed his mind. Roberts' rationalization: ObamaCare is a tax, not a penalty. He reached this conclusion even as the Obama administration insisted ObamaCare is not a tax.

The ObamaCare decision now joins a list of infamous decisions by the Court including Dred Scott plus Roe v. Wade and its companion decision, Doe v. Bolton. What can we do? Certainly we must educate others on the truths of the pro-life position.

Currently, abortion practitioners in Alabama, Arkansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri, Ohio, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Texas, and Utah are required to maintain local hospital admitting privileges.

Even though such laws do not make abortion illegal, this regulation could make Mississippi the first abortion-free state in the union – along with reducing the number of abortuaries in areas of those other states.

## “WHERE DO THE CANDIDATES STAND ON LIFE?”

**Roe v. Wade & Abortion** – The 1973 *Roe v. Wade* and its companion, *Doe v. Bolton*, decisions together essentially legalized abortion on demand throughout the U.S., resulting in more than 54 million abortions since then.

**Mitt Romney** – “I support the reversal of *Roe v. Wade* because it is a bad law and bad medicine. *Roe* was a misguided ruling that was a result of a small group of activist federal judges legislating from the bench.”

**Taxpayer Funding for Abortion** – H.R. 3 would codify the Hyde Amendment which prohibits federal funding of abortion. Over one million Americans are alive today because of the Hyde Amendment.

**Mitt Romney** – “I support the Hyde Amendment, which broadly bars the use of federal funds for abortions.”

**Funding for Abortion Providers** – Each year, hundreds of millions of taxpayer dollars are given to Planned Parenthood, the nation’s largest abortion provider reporting 332,278 abortions in 2009.

**Mitt Romney** – “I will support efforts to prohibit federal funding for any organization like Planned Parenthood, which primarily performs abortions or offers abortion-related services.”

**Obamacare Health Care Law** – The Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ObamaCare) will provide funding for health plans that pay for abortion on demand and will lead to the rationing of lifesaving medical treatments.

**Mitt Romney** – “Obamacare will violate that crucial first principle of medicine: ‘do no harm.’” Mitt Romney believes that ObamaCare must be repealed. (Statement on Mitt Romney’s website)

**Rights of Conscience** – The *Respect for Rights of Conscience Act* (S.1467, H.R. 1179) would exempt institutions or individuals from providing health coverage for services that violate their religious or moral convictions.

**Mitt Romney** – “...on day one I will eliminate the Obama Administration rule that compels religious institutions to violate the tenets of their own faith. Such rules don’t belong in the America that I believe in.”

## **Nurses and Doctors in the United States**

After 43 years, I don’t miss the starched nursing uniforms and glass IV bottles of my youth but I certainly do miss the idealism and ethical unity that I shared with my colleagues during that time.” In capitulation to the new ideal of “choice,” we [pro-life] doctors and nurses find ourselves ostracized from our professional organizations for being “politically incorrect” when we oppose abortion and stand up for discrimination-free medical care for the disabled.

We are warned not to be “judgmental” when a terminally ill person asks to die. At the same time, we see our conscience rights being legally dismantled with excuses such as: “Doctors, nurses and pharmacists choose professions that put patients’ rights first. If they foresee that priority becoming problematic for them, they should choose another profession.”

This did not happen overnight but rather by small and ever deepening steps. The result has not been a more compassionate and just society but rather a culture with a false sense of power and entitlement. We have been seduced into believing not only that we deserve control over having or not having children but also the degree of perfection of those chosen children.

We think we deserve a life in which the seriously ill or disabled don’t financially or emotionally burden us. We think we deserve to decide when our own lives are not worth living, and have a right to be painlessly dispatched by a medical person. And we desperately but ultimately futilely want to believe that our actions and attitudes will not have terrible consequences.

It will take all of us openly and constantly challenging this culture of death to restore the traditional respect for life that protects all our lives.

## **Adult Stem Cells in Breast Milk Found to Work like Embryonic Cells**

Researchers in Australia have found stem cells in breast milk that, like embryonic stem cells, can become many different types of cells in the body.

The Hartmann Human Lactation Research Group at the University of Western Australia have found stem cells in human breast milk that they have turned into bone, brain, liver, and pancreatic cells that produce insulin.

A solution to the ethical dilemma of using human embryonic stem cells to treat human diseases could be staring us in the face.

Five years ago, Dr Foteini Hassiotou, part of the Hartmann Human Lactation Research Group, found that some of these stem cells are very similar to embryonic stem cells — the most potent and useful stem cell of all.

These human breast milk cells can potentially turn into many different types of cells, and offer staggering potential for treating a huge range of human diseases.

Much like embryonic stem cells, these “potent and useful” stem cells found in breast milk – unlike embryonic stem cells – do not require the destruction of human embryos to harvest them,

The stem cells found in human breast milk are easily collected without surgery. Human breast milk may be more than just nourishment for newborns. It may contain hope for a multitude of diseases. Hope that does not require the destruction of innocent human life.
